Table labels are at the beginning and ideas for each group follow.

You may only have Literacy groups run for 4 days instead of 5 (just leave a day blank)

Choose which table rotations you wish to use and print out, laminate, then write the activities you plan to do on each.

Teachers usually have 4-6 rotating groups, so select the ones which appeal to you and the needs of your class most. (Eg: A kindergarten class may not do spelling)

This is the station that the teacher is at.

Ideas— Guided Reading for 3 days, Guided Writing for 2 days. (Reading or writing with teacher, explicit word work, dictation, comprehension strategies)

Rad Writing:

Ideas-

Mon: Journal (any topic, eg: On the weekend, the best pet).

Tues: 'If I was' (another Teacher Brain download. Students imagine themselves as someone/something else, eq: a dentist, a dragon).

Wed: Writing Prompt (great to laminate on the back of 'If I was'.

Thurs: Text Type you are studying

Fri: Creative Writing

(Sticker stories, write a story with only 50 words, story starter, put 8 specified words into a story)

Splendid Spelling:

Ideas-

Mon: Write out list + Pictures

Tues: List + Sentences

Wed: List + Making (matchsticks, popsticks, pipe-cleaners, play doh)

Thurs: List + Clues

Fri: List + Shape boxes

(Definitions, alphabetical order, consonant and vowel highlight, rainbow words, shape words (written as a snake, tree, etc), rhyming, word building, synonyms and antonyms, painting with water, syllables, write out words with other hand, trace on buddy's back, oral spell with buddy, hangman, find—a—word, Teacher Brain downloads!)

Exciting Everything:

Ideas- Everything else/little bits and pieces

Mon: Phonics

Tues: Handwriting worksheet (laminated pages or printed workbook)

Wed: Dictation

Thurs: Grammar

Fri: Visual Literacy (Teacher Brain download)

(Editing, tongue twisters, read with parent, write the room, puzzles)

Brilliant Bookstudy:

This can be the station where students change their homereaders, complete silent reading, re-read known texts.

You can also put printed booklets at this station (grammar, etc)

Wed: Book review or answering questions about book

Thurs: Book Art (Book cover, favourite part, character)

Creative Computers:

Ideas— Choose your favourite websites or programs, eg: Reading Eggs, Letterland, Copacabana Get Smart, Cool Maths.

Students can publish a story they have written, or set a research topic.

Magic Making:

This is the 'fun' station. It is good to have some games and easy activities to give little minds a rest, as they are so busy at all their other stations!

Ideas- Great for fine motor practise

Mon: Play Doh

Tues: Card Game/Dominos

Wed: Pattern Blocks

Thurs: Beading

Fri: Free Drawing

(Catch-up work, toys, geoboards, bingo, uno, blocks, boardgames)

Cool Comprehension:

Ideas— Use Comprehension boxes (if you school has them), worksheets based on the book they are studying, questions you make up on your board, Naplan practise sheets, etc.
